COMMERCIAL ENTRY FEE: All entries that represent a Business or Commercial entity are Required to include an **\$100.00** Entry Fee along with the Parade Application.
FLOAT MUST BE FULLY DECORATED THIS INCLUDES BOTH SIDES
NO ENTRY FEE for Non Profit Organizations
MAKE CHECK PAYABLE TO **THE OLD MINERS ASSOCIATION**

FLOATS: ... may carry the name only of the sponsoring firm or organization in addition to a Theme wording.
Float judging will be based on Execution of Theme, Originality of Design and Spectator Appeal.
FINAL JUDGING PRIOR TO PARADE START.

1. All participants must be uniformed, costumed or appropriately attired.
2. Any entries consisting of advertising or expressing political, social, etc. viewpoints will not be acceptable.
3. All entries in the parade must be approved by the Parade Committee. Any deviation from the rules must be approved by the Parade Committee prior to the acceptance of the parade application.
4. PARADE WILL START PROMPTLY AT 12:30 PM
5. The Parade Committee accepts no responsibility for false statements made by applicants or entrants.
6. FORWARD motion must be maintained throughout the parade route. No Stopping to Perform
7. Violations subject to disqualification.
8. No one under the age of 9 will be permitted to march (without special permission)
9. Please carry an identification banner if possible.
10. All entries must be in by **July 3, 2009**
11. Check-in booth closing time: 12:15 PM. All units must be checked in by this time.
12. At no time is any unit allowed to hand out or throw anything along the parade route.
13. No shooting of Firearms, no sirens or loud noises that interfere with other units.
14. No vehicle honking (especially air horns) is permitted.
15. ALL Vehicles MUST be decorated, unless pulling a float.
